- Twin & double rooms available to 2 students booking together. This does not apply to our London student house where an individual student can book a bed in a twin room.
- Late arrivals (after 22:00) may be subject to a late arrival fee. Please check at time of booking.
- If you are applying for a student visa, your accommodation will not be confirmed until the visa has been granted. We require notification of visa confirmation at least 2 weeks before arrival, otherwise we cannot guarantee your first choice of accommodation will be available.
- Homestay Christmas week supplement fee applies week commencing 19 Dec: £40.
- A special diet (celiac, halal, kosher, vegan, lactose intolerance) supplement of £30/week applies.

Insurance

Before you arrive in the UK we strongly recommend that you take our insurance for your own financial and personal security.

You can take out your own insurance or take out the international student policy offered by Endsleigh which has been specifically designed for overseas students studying in the UK.

Insurance is available from £7 per week. Organising this is extremely easy and can be done at the same time as booking your course.

If you are studying in Dublin insurance is compulsory. Students who are arranging their own insurance will be required to show evidence upon arrival.
