Our Teaching Method

New York Language Center uses a practical approach to teaching our students English. Our highly conversational classes emphasize oral fluency as a major goal. From the very first class at even the basic level, students will use English in a practical and realistic way. We believe that the ability to ask questions is a critical skill and we encourage active participation and natural production of language forms. In order to learn English, the language must become spontaneous. All classes include realistic practice in real life situations. Translation is not allowed. Many students who have studied English in their home countries know the language passively but cannot use it. We try to break that barrier.

Our instructors have specific goals for each week. These goals encompass what students can do at the end of the lesson. Oral and written assessments allow students to gauge their achievement.

All of our teachers are certified by the New York State Education Department. Many have at least one year of ESL/EFL teaching experience. All members of our faculty have ESL teacher certification training. Each must complete a thorough orientation prior to teaching with NYLC. Additionally, instructors are observed frequently by an Academic Coordinator to ensure their effectiveness and participate in ongoing professional development.

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM (20 HOURS PER WEEK) Monday- Friday, Mornings or Afternoons Course Length: 8 weeks per session

The Intensive Language Program comprises eight levels of ESL and Post-Advanced classes. Post-Advanced classes include academic level Listening/Speaking as well as Reading/Writing courses, TOEFL prep and Business English. All courses offer integrated skills as well as enhanced practice with authentic materials such as newspaper articles, podcasts and online videos. Students interact with real English to improve listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Weekly assessments ensure that educational goals are met. Students on an F-1 visa must choose this program.

ESL/EFL SEMI-INTENSIVE LANGUAGE PROGRAM (16 HOURS PER WEEK) Monday- Thursday, Mornings or Afternoons Course Length: 8 weeks per session

The Semi Intensive Language Program comprises eight levels of ESL and Post-Advanced classes. It is perfect

for tourists who would like an English language learning experience and still have free time to explore the city. Post- Advanced classes include academic level Listening/ Speaking as well as Reading/Writing courses, TOEFL prep and Business English. All courses offer integrated skills as well as enhanced practice with authentic materials such as newspaper articles, podcasts and online videos. Students interact with real English to improve listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Weekly assessments ensure that educational goals are met. Students do not attend on Fridays.

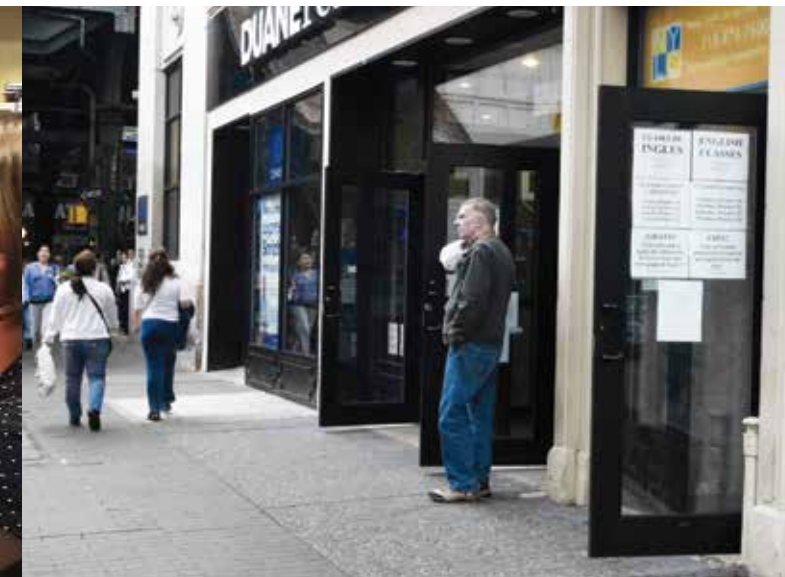
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Jackson Heights, Queens

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The Bronx

The Bronx location offers an Integrated Skills Program to local students. Students will gain the opportunity to study and practice English language communication skills including listening, speaking, reading and writing that will allow them to function in social situations, improve their employment prospects, and participate more fully in the community. The program is designed for all non-native English speakers from any language, group or nationality. Students will progress towards language self-sufficiency upon completion of the program. The program is offered in beginner, low intermediate, intermediate, upper intermediate and conversational levels.

COURSES IN PROGRAM

The program offers basic language skills for the complete beginner through more advanced skills for the higher level learner. Students learn the communication strategies and vocabulary needed to gain confidence even if this is their first experience in a language program.

Classes are offered from 8am-10 pm and a special ESL program is offered on the weekends.

New York Language Center apartments are in clean, safe buildings equipped with furniture, linens, kitchen utensils and wi-fi. These apartments are rented specifically for students.

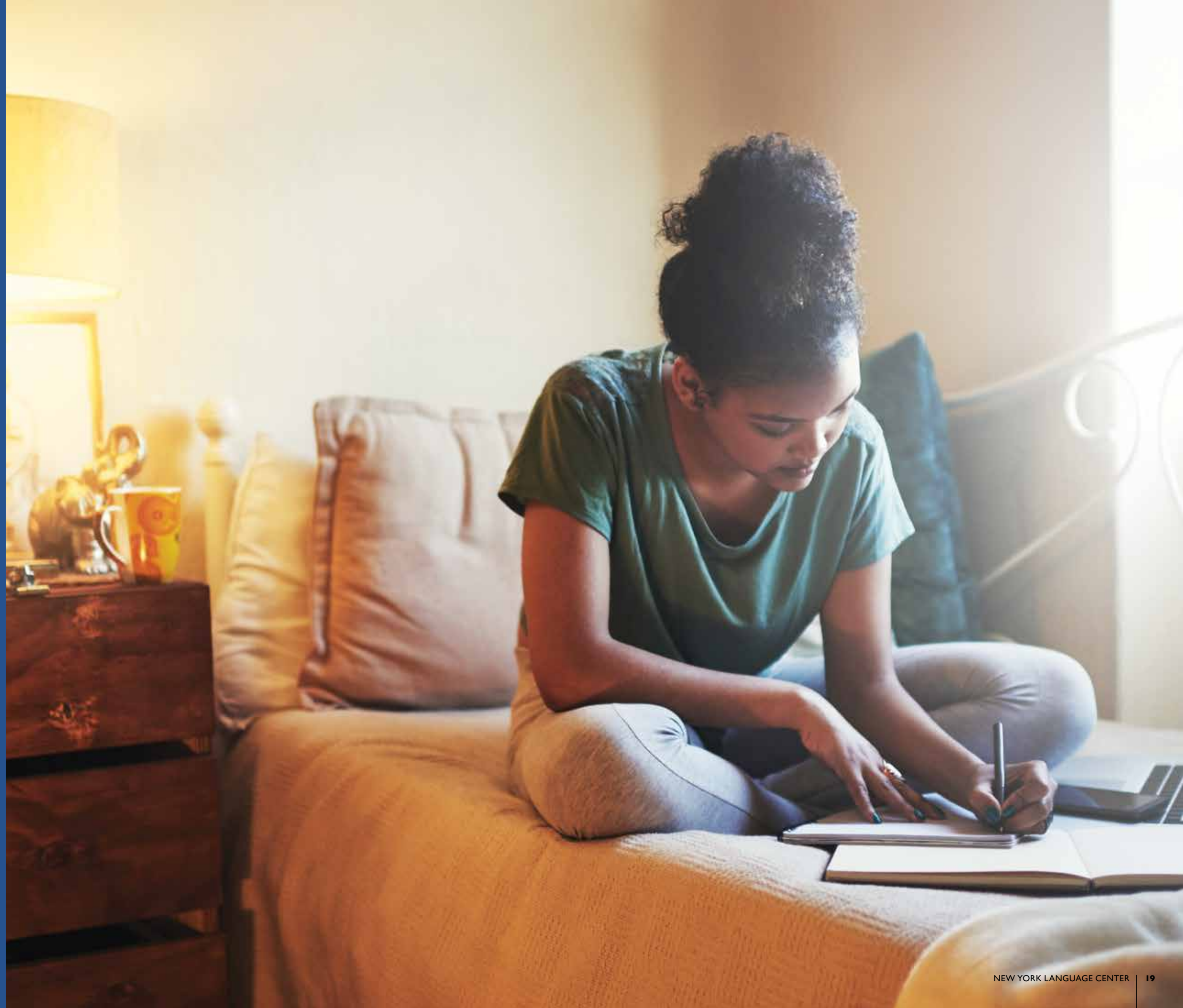
AIRPORT TRANSFERS

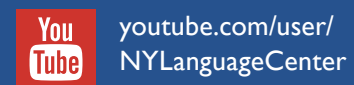
