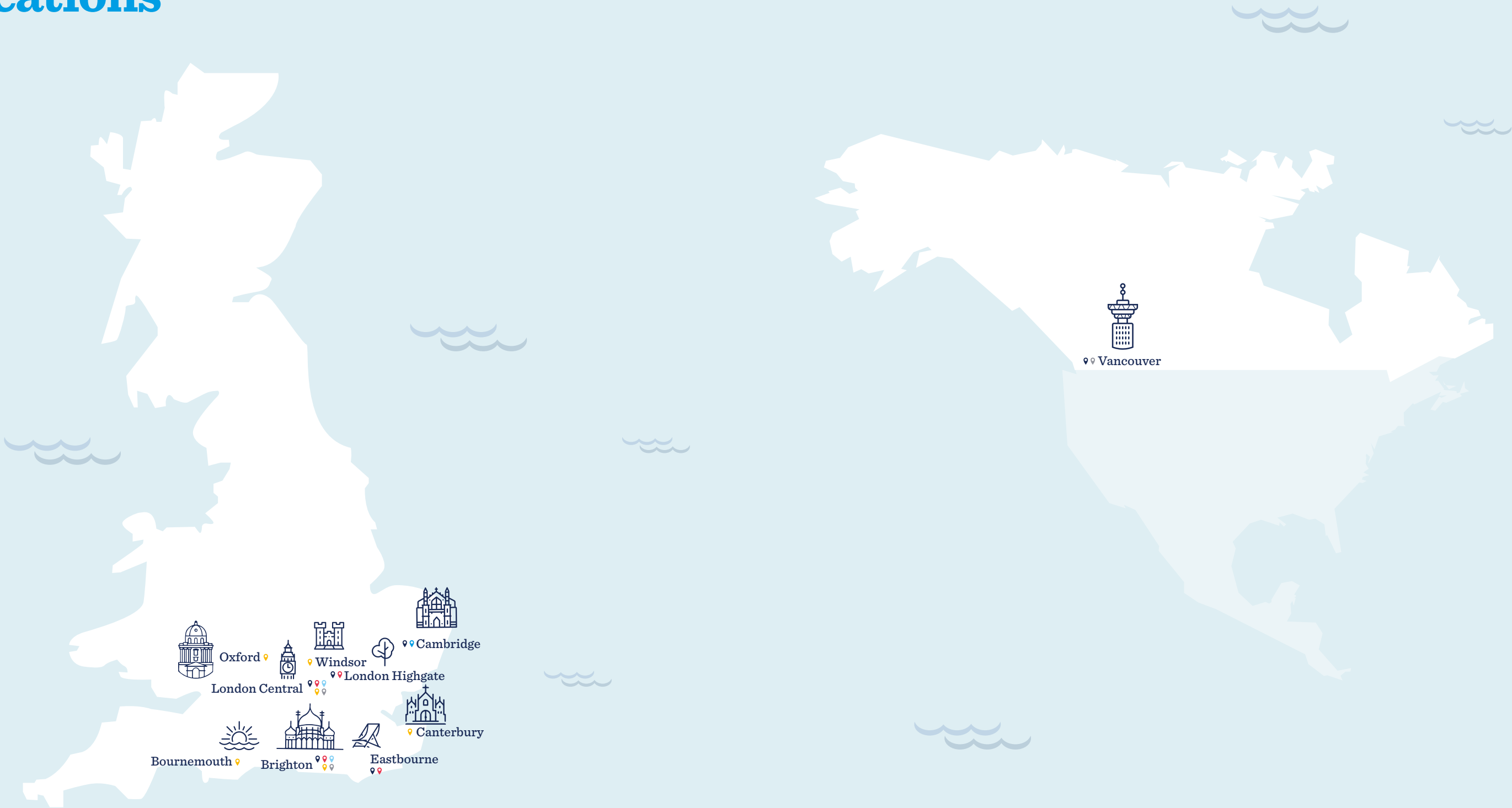

Study in Safety at St Giles

When we reopened our schools, we implemented safety measures including:

- Implementing social distancing
- Providing hand sanitiser around the school
- Recommended use of face coverings in common areas
- A socially distanced social programme, including activities such as barbeques outside and excursions to some of the best sights in the area
- Setting out detailed health and safety plans to ensure swift action in case of emergencies

We will continue to implement these measures for as long as they are recommended by our local governments and industry associations.

Quarantine with St Giles

For students needing to quarantine on arrival, we offered:

- A warm welcome from our homestay hosts and accommodation team
- The option to start learning immediately with online lessons delivered on St Giles Live or an in-class Zoom connection
- A quarantine homestay full-board package
- A choice of homestay or residential accommodation

We know that COVID 19 has created a lot of uncertainty surrounding travel, so throughout the pandemic, and as necessary in the future, we have committed to offering flexibility for our students. This has included the St Giles Flexible Booking Guarantee and providing more comprehensive medical insurance coverage for students who opt for our student insurance package.

Goksu arrived in Brighton in February 2020, a month before the UK lockdown. She stayed with her host family and studied online at St Giles Live.

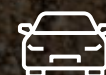

Your class

Before you start your course at St Giles, you will take our online placement test so we can make sure you are placed in the right class. You will then be put in a class with students who have a similar level of English, and where possible are from a variety of countries. At St Giles, we have a maximum class size of 12 at our year round centres, 10 for students under 16 studying at Eastbourne, Cambridge and London Highgate, and 15 at our Junior Summer Centres. For even smaller class sizes, students can opt for our Platinum classes (available at selected locations), where the maximum class size is 5. This means that you will enjoy personal attention from your teachers, which will help you make faster progress.
